Introduction

- 1. At its 60th session, the General Assembly showed the interest to know in detail the allocation of the expenditure to the projects of the Institute. The Secretariat prepared documents to this effect, that were submitted to the Governing Council at its 86th session, held in Rome from 16 to 18 April 2007, and to the Finance Committee at its 62nd session, held in Rome on 4 October 2007, with a view to receiving their opinion.
- 2. The Governing Council and the Finance Committee shared the interest shown by the General Assembly and agreed that this information may permit to the institutions of UNIDROIT to have a more precise picture of the finances of the Institute.
- 3. To this effect, the allocation of expenditure to the projects of the Institute is illustrated in this document; for 2006 only the legislative activities are included in this paper, where for 2007 all the activities are covered.
