#### Introduction

The first estimates of receipts and expenditure for the 2017 financial year prepared by the Secretariat (F.C. (79) 2) were examined by the Finance Committee at its 79<sup>th</sup> session (Rome, 17 March 2016), in accordance with Article 31 of the Regulations. Those first estimates were then submitted to the Governing Council, which at its 95<sup>th</sup> session (Rome, 18 to 20 May 2016), established the draft Budget for 2016, as set forth in the appendix to this document, taking into account the opinion expressed by the Finance Committee.

In line with the Institute's practice, the draft Budget resulting from this procedure has been submitted to the Governments of UNIDROIT member States with a view to their formulation of such observations as they might wish to make by 2 September 2016. At the time of writing (1 September 2016), no comments had been received. Overall, the Secretariat proposes a total expenditure of € 2,271,870.00 for the year 2017, which represents no increasecompared to the expenditure authorised under the 2016 budget. The Secretariat proposes to cover the Institute's expenditure in 2017 as follows:

Statutory contributions of other member States<sup>1</sup>  $\in$  2,223,870.00 Other receipts  $\in$  33,000.00

The draft budget for 2017 does not anticipate a balance being carried over from the 2016 financial year, nor does it include estimates on financing from private sources for particular projects and activities (e.g. organisation of meetings, sponsoring of research fellows, scholarship, purchase of books and journals and the promotion of UNIDROIT instruments). The Secretariat will continue to solicit voluntary contributions of this type, which will be accounted for separately.

The Secretariat would propose that the statutory contributions of all member States for 2017 be calculated on the basis of a unit of contribution amounting to € 2,530.

Under this proposal, the statutory contributions of member States would be as follows:

At its 80<sup>th</sup> session (Rome, 29 September 2016), the Finance Committee expressed itself in favour of the draft budget for the 2017 financial year and recommended that the General Assembly adopt the draft Budget for the 2017 financial year.

In the light of the foregoing, the General Assembly, at its 75<sup>th</sup> session, may wish to adopt the draft budget for 2017 as in the Appendix to this document.

- 1 No change is proposed for 2017.
- The Secretariat estimates the interests earned on deposits in checking accounts to be the same as in previous years.
- This sum represents the share of the Office for Italy and San Marino of the International Labour Organization in the operating expenses of the premises of UNIDROIT.
- The Secretariat estimates the income earned from the sale of publications to be approximately the same as in previous years.
- The extraordinary income estimated under this Chapter relates to the reimbursement by the Government of the United States of America of federal, state and municipal taxes payable by a US citizen appointed to the Unidroit Secretariat, under the terms of a tax reimbursement agreement signed between Unidroit and the Government of the United States of America on 17 September 2013 (see Expenditure, note 3) .

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#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE DRAFT BUDGET - EXPENDITURE**

Purpose of expenditure: to cover travel and subsistence expenses incurred by the members of the Governing Council and of the Permanent Committee in their attendance of sessions of those bodies; the fees due to the auditor appointed by the General Assembly; the costs of hearings of the Administrative Tribunal, registrar services and sums awarded by the Tribunal for settlement of claims; the costs incurred by Unidroit in organising meetings of committees of experts and other meetings associated with the organisation's Work Programme; the travel and subsistence expenses incurred by representatives of Unidroit, members of staff and collaborators in connection with the attendance of meetings of other organisations with which Unidroit cooperates, as well as missions intended to further awareness of Unidroit's work in general and, where appropriate, to encourage accession to the Statute of the Organisation; cover the cost of simultaneous interpretation at meetings held by Unidroit; the cost of representation functions, such as receptions and similar events organised by Unidroit in connection with its meetings.

The Secretariat proposes an increase of € 30,000.00 in Article 4 (Committees of Experts) of Chapter 1, by reallocating to this line of expenditure savings expected to be made under Article 1 (Salaries of Categories A, B and C staff and consultant) of Chapter 2 (Salaries and allowances) and under Article 1 (Insurance against disablement, old age and sickness) of Chapter 3 (Social security charges) (see notes 2 and 4 below). This sum will be used by the Secretariat to cover meetings costs, as well as cost of commissioning research and studies needed in connection with the implementation of the new Work Programme for the Triennium 2017-2019.

**Purpose of expenditure:** to cover the salaries and allowances of the professional, administrative, secretarial and library members of UNIDROIT staff as well remuneration of a consultant.

The Secretariat expects that the costs of salary raises due to regular step-in-grade increments pursuant to the UNIDROIT Regulations will be entirely offset by the cost reductions resulting from departure of long-serving staff members during the year 2016 and recruitment of new staff members at a lower entry level. The Secretariat also intends to keep one part-time position vacant, utilising the resources thus freed for commissioning studies by outside experts.

The Secretariat thus proposes a decrease of € 28.538,00 for 2017.

Purpose of expenditure: to cover the cost of federal, state and municipal taxes payable by a US citizen appointed to the UNIDROIT Secretariat. These costs will be refunded by the Government of the United States of America, under the terms of a tax reimbursement agreement signed in September 2013.

The first financial year in respect of which taxes were refunded by UNIDROIT was the year 2015. As of the time of this writing, the reimbursement claims had not yet been processed by the Government of the United States of America, the Secretariat has retained for the year 2017 the estimate figure stated in the budget approved for the year 2016.

<sup>4</sup> **Purpose of expenditure:** insurance coverage of staff members against disability, old age and sickness. With a few exceptions, all staff members of staff are insured for these purposes with the Italian social security system (INPS).

As a result of staff movements forecasted for 2016, a  $\leq$  1,462 decrease in expenditure under this article is expected for 2017.

<sup>5</sup> **Purpose of expenditure:** insurance coverage of all staff members against accidents. All staff members are insured for this purpose with a private Italian insurance company.

No change is proposed for 2017.

<sup>6</sup> **Purpose of expenditure:** payments to one retired member of staff to cover the periods, in the past, during which he was not covered for social security purposes.

No change is proposed for 2017.

Purpose of expenditure: to cover ordinary running expenses of UNIDROIT (purchase of stationary, telephone charges, postage of materials and correspondence etc.).

No change is proposed for 2017.

<sup>8</sup> **Purpose of expenditure:** to cover utilities fees (electricity, water and gas bills), building maintenance costs (insurance, ordinary repairs in the building, maintenance of elevators) and charges for municipal services (i.e. waste disposal).

No change is proposed for 2017.

<sup>9</sup> **Purpose of expenditure:** to cover the cost of acquisitions for the Library's stock of books and the maintenance of its subscriptions to law journals, binding of periodicals and subscriptions to electronic journals and databases.

No change is proposed for 2017.

Overall, the Secretariat proposes a total expenditure of  $\in$  2,271,870.00 for the year 2017, which equals the expenditure authorised under the 2016 budget.
