- 1. The budget for the 2012 financial year, approved by the General Assembly at its 69^{th} session (Rome, 1 December 2011), provided for actual expenditure of € 2,359,025.00 to be met by actual receipts of € 2,329,025.00 and an estimated surplus from 2011 of € 30,000,00. The budget also provided for receipts and expenditure in the special accounts to balance at € 6,000.00.
- 2. The Accounts for the 2012 financial year indicate that actual receipts amounted to \in 2,154,381.69. Owing to a limitation of actual expenditure to \in 2,079,171.29, the cash account at the close of the 2012 financial year showed a balance of \in 75,210.40.
- 3. Receipts and expenditures in the special accounts, amounting to \leqslant 2,067.57, show a balance. The credit balance in the Working Capital Fund at the at the close of the 2012 financial year was \leqslant 365,872.45.
