TWO TWO-MONTH SCHOLARSHIPS IN ROME, ITALY FOR LEGAL RESEARCH FUNDED BY THE *UK FOUNDATION FOR INTERNATIONAL UNIFORM LAW*

The *UK Foundation for International Uniform Law* has established scholarships for academic research into international uniform law and/or comparative law at the International Institute for the Unification of Private Law (UNIDROIT) in Rome, Italy. Two such scholarships were awarded in 2007 and two in 2008.

These scholarships provide for a two-month stay each, tenable in the first semester of 2010, and cover living expenses (accommodation and daily allowance) in Rome for the designated period. Beneficiaries are expected to meet their own travel expenses.

To apply, a detailed research project is to be submitted in relation to one of the following topics included in the current UNIDROIT Work Programme

- Model Law on Leasing
- International interests in mobile equipment
- Transactions on transnational and connected capital markets

In case of equally meritorious candidates, preference will be given to lawyers from a developing country or a country in economic transition.

Deadline for applications : 15 October 2009.
