Unidroit Principles and ICC model contracts

Rome, 8 November 2013

Parties engaged in the negotiation of an international contract are frequently faced with the problem of agreeing on a neutral solution when it comes to agree on the governing law.

In addition to the traditional solutions, such as the choice of the law of a third country, the option of having recourse to transnational rules instead of a domestic law is receiving more and more acceptance in recent years, also thanks to the growing success of the Unidroit Principles, which offer a clear and well-balanced alternative legal framework.

The purpose of this conference is to analyse and discuss a number of contractual solutions based on the Unidroit Principles, such as in particular the "Model clauses for the use of the Unidroit Principles" adopted by Unidroit in June of this year and the choice-of-law clauses contained in several model contracts published by the International Chamber of Commerce.
