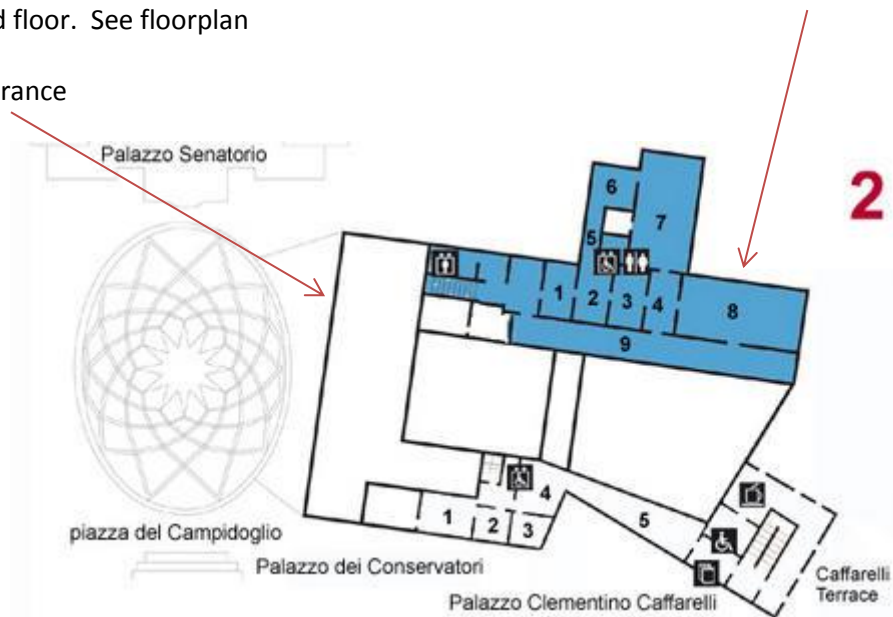

Due to the limited seating capacity of the Pietro da Cortona hall, those wishing to participate in the Conference are invited to register as soon as possible by sending the registration form attached to the invitation to the UNIDROIT Secretariat by 24 April at the latest. The UNIDROIT Secretariat will send a confirmation of the registration.

Those that have not registered beforehand and received confirmation will be denied access to the Capitoline Museums and the conference hall.

Participants will receive a badge at the registration counter located at the entrance of the Capitoline Museums by the ticket desk, and will be required to wear it in a visible manner throughout the Conference.
