1. The Budget for the 2007 financial year, approved by the General Assembly at its 60<sup>th</sup> session on 1 December 2006, provided for actual expenditure of € 2,199,850.00 to be met by receipts of € 2,149,850.00 and an estimated surplus from 2006 of € 50,000.00. The Budget also provided for receipts and expenditure in the special accounts to balance at € 6,000.00.
2. The Accounts for the 2006 financial year indicate that actual receipts (including the 2006 surplus amounting to € 52,599.52) totalled € 2,274,232.72 and actual expenditure € 2,156,996.71, yielding a surplus for the year as a whole of € 117,236.01. Receipts and expenditures in the special accounts, amounting to € 9,878.50, show a balance.
3. The variations in the receipts show an overall increase of € 74,382.72 as against the original estimates; it is however to be noted that an important part of this sum (€ 59,783.08) is attributable to an extra-statutory contribution of the Government of the United Kingdom, paid in 2007, and thus included in the 2007 Accounts, but to be affected to the 2008 salary of the Deputy Secretary-General/Chief Administrator.

4. To facilitate the reading of the Accounts, a summary of the receipts (in euro) follows:

4. The variations in expenditure for 2007, which show a reduction of expenditure of € 38,974.79, are illustrated analytically in the Accounts 2007.

5. The surplus may be explained as follows (in euro):

<sup>1</sup> This sum includes all the statutory contributions received in the financial year 2007; for an analytical description see the 2007 Accounts.

<sup>2</sup> During the financial year 2007 the Government of the United Kingdom has paid two extra-statutory contributions, allocated to the 2007 and 2008 salary of the Deputy Secretary-General/Chief Administrator.

<sup>3</sup> For reasons of accounting, the donation of € 5,000 was paid by the International Law Foundation at the beginning of 2008 and therefore will be included in the 2008 Accounts.
