Nigeria is in arrears for more than two consecutive years and thus, unless the outstanding amounts are settled, will lose its right to vote at the 77th session of the General Assembly (Rome, 6 December 2018). See UNIDROIT Statute, art. 16(7) ("Participating Governments which are more than two years in arrears with the payment of their contribution shall lose the right to vote in the General Assembly until they regularise their position. Furthermore, no account shall be taken of such Governments in the process of arriving at the majority required by Article 19 of this Statute.").
