In coordination with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), a project entitled “Legal Structure of Agricultural Enterprises” was approved by the UNIDROIT Governing Council and the General Assembly in 2019 to be developed during the 2020-2022 Work Programme. The work on “Legal Structure of Agricultural Enterprises” is the third project of the tripartite partnership between UNIDROIT/FAO/IFAD, after the successful drafting of the [Legal Guide on Contract Farming](#) and the [Legal Guide on Agricultural Land Investment Contracts \(ALIC\)](#).

Based on the [feasibility study and background paper](#) prepared by the UNIDROIT Secretariat in 2020, this webinar will seek to receive input from academia, stakeholders, institutional actors and organisations to further define the content and scope of the potential new international guiding instrument. The webinar will be held at the seat of UNIDROIT in Rome, with the possibility of participating via video conference, on **25 February 2021**.
