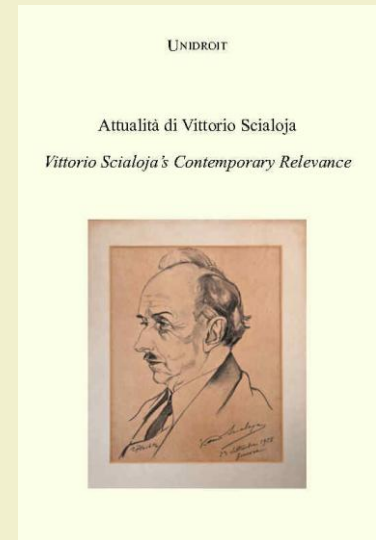


Attualità di Vittorio Scialoja / *Vittorio Scialoja's Contemporary Relevance*
