ANNOTATIONS

1. The 107th session of the Governing Council will be held at the seat of UNIDROIT on 27-29 May 2026. In-person participation is expected for Governing Council Members, although remote connection will exceptionally be made available where in-person attendance is not possible. Remote participation for registered Observers is also possible. In order to accommodate participation across as many time zones as possible, meeting hours shall be from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. CEST on the first two days and from 9:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. on the last day.

Item No. 2 – Appointment of the First and Second Vice-Presidents of the Governing Council

2. At its annual sessions since 1977, the Governing Council has elected a First and a Second Vice-President who, in accordance with Article 11 of the Regulations of the Institute, will hold office until the following ordinary session, which is convened once a year. At present, the post of First Vice-President is occupied by the doyen of the Council and that of Second Vice-President by one of the most senior Council Members, the latter on the basis of the criterion of rotation since 1994.

Item No. 11(d) – UNIDROIT Historical Archives

3. A presentation of the UNIDROIT Historical Archives will be held on Wednesday 27 May at 5:30 p.m. (*to be confirmed*) with participation of a representative of the Ministry of Culture (Italy).

Item No. 14 – Date and venue of futures sessions of the Governing Council

4. The Governing Council shall begin its 108th session on 9 December 2026 at the seat of UNIDROIT in Rome, one day prior to the joint meeting with the 86th session of the General Assembly. Suggested dates for the in-person session in 2027 are 12-14, 19-21 or 26-28 May 2027.

Item No. 15 – Any other Business

5. Professor Anna Veneziano's term of office as Deputy Secretary-General expires on 30 September 2027. The Governing Council is invited to endorse the Permanent Committee's recommendation to renew her mandate for 5 years until 30 September 2032.
