Registration at the EBRD headquarters

For security reasons, all guests must check in at reception on arrival to obtain an EBRD access badge. Guests must present photo identification. Badges must be worn at all times during the conference.

Free wi-fi

A free Wi-Fi connection is available to all conference guests. The official Wi-Fi code is shown on the EBRD badges.



Accessibility

- Five Bank Street can be reached on foot via the marked pedestrian routes; access to the main reception on Bank Street is step-free.
- The event room is fully accessible with step-free entry. If you require assistance, please contact us in advance.
- The recommended taxi drop-off point is 25 Bank Street, by Heron Quays DLR station — the closest step-free public transport option.

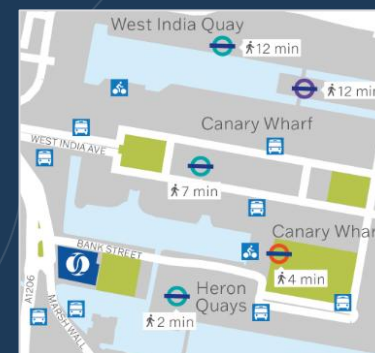
Public transport links

- Canary Wharf Underground station is the nearest. It is served by the Jubilee and Elizabeth Lines.
- Heron Quays DLR station is another metro station which serves the southern part of the Canary Wharf office complex.

Visitor parking

EBRD visitor parking is available only for visitors with mobility issues; other cars must depart and return later to collect.

The closest parking facility is Westferry Circus Car Park (E14 4DA), entrance on West India Avenue (cashless payment only).

Art and exhibitions



EBRD's 35th anniversary

The EBRD marked its 35-year anniversary in 2026 by establishing a [permanent historical exhibition](#) in the lobby of the Bank's headquarters in London. The display, which will evolve over time, presents a visual narrative of the Bank's journey and impact, from its origins after the collapse of communism in Europe through to the present day and its expansion into new regions. One of the current exhibition highlights is a special feature on the EBRD's role in international efforts to make Chernobyl safe, marking 40 years since the 1986 disaster.

The EBRD's former headquarters housed several art works in keeping with its international character. Outside the Board Room stood a wooden articulated winged horse created by Christian Renonciat, which has now been moved to the new headquarters at Five Bank Street in Canary Wharf. Other works included tributes to Leonardo da Vinci and Nicolas Copernicus. A large metal sphere in the Bishopsgate reception area symbolised a world without frontiers.



Public art & events

Canary Wharf events vary from impromptu performances in the Crossrail Place Roof Garden to large scale events in our parks and squares. See [What's On in Canary Wharf](#).

Also, Canary Wharf is home to London's largest collection of outdoor public art. The collection of more than 100 pieces is a mix of stand-alone sculptures and integrated architectural works.

Visit the Eden Dock

In a pioneering partnership with the Eden Project the historic Middle Dock was reimagined, into Eden Dock — a waterfront oasis of interconnected pontoons and aquatic islands.

Eden Dock is designed to elevate mental and physical wellbeing through the power of nature.



Open spaces roof garden

A selection of versatile spaces, free to visit and open to everyone, used every day for classes, performances, informal gatherings or simply relaxation.

Careful planting and cultivation create green spaces that are beautiful year-round, with flowers, plants, shrubs and trees that change with the season.

The National Maritime Museum, Queen's House, Cutty Sark and the Royal Observatory are all a quick, easy journey from Canary Wharf, and within easy walking distance of each other.
